Directions

The hotel is situated directly beside Sheffield United's Bramall Lane football stadium.

By air and by train

One mile from Sheffield railway station. Sheffield is just over two hours by rail from London St Pancras. Direct train links from Manchester, East Midlands and Leeds/Bradford airports/less than an hour by road.

By road

Sheffield's motorway link is the M1, junctions 33 and 34. Leave at junction 33 and proceed into the city centre along the Parkway (A630). Ample free car parking on site.

Sheffield's National Coach Service's central pick-up and terminal point is at the Transport Interchange.
